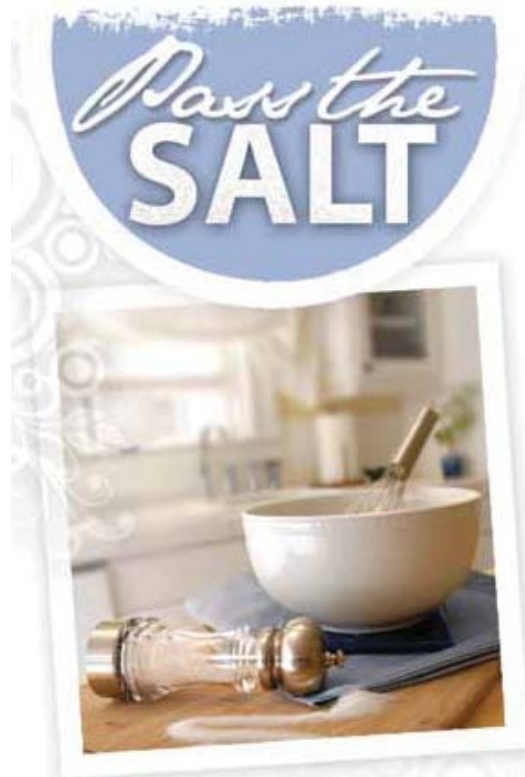

FREMONT ALLIANCE WOMEN IN MISSIONS AND PRAYER is an auxiliary of the Christian & Missionary Alliance (C&MA) organized since 1961 to support and pray for C&MA missionaries and worldwide ministries. The organization has a rich history of allowing women at the small group level to impact mission fields around the world in very real and tangible ways.

How does it work?

In a small group setting you can...

- **DISCOVER** relationships of mutual encouragement and friendship in one of our two monthly **Fellowship Groups**. Together we study God's word, hear about the work and needs of our missionaries, raise mission funds, pray, and enjoy good food.
- **LEARN** the tremendous power of prayer at our monthly **Prayer Day**, as we lift up the personal prayer requests of C&MA missionaries.
- **ENJOY** the satisfaction of meeting the physical needs of Alliance workers through monthly **Projects and Quilting**. Whether it's rolling bandages for hospitals, cutting used stamps, stitching a quilt for missionaries, or other projects, this is a hands-on way to make a difference.
- **CONNECT** with the women in your church, state, and across the country at women's retreats and by supporting our annual **National Project**.
